

Vaccination Policy – The Corporation of Lorne Park Baptist Church (LPBC)

Purpose

The Corporation of Lorne Park Baptist Church (LPBC) is required to provide a documented policy for the purposes of direction for employees, volunteers, and attendees regarding COVID19 Vaccinations.

Our Position

Our position has been, and will continue to be to [follow the guidance of the Region of Peel Health Unit](#) and to comply with the Ontario government regulations around protocols and safety. It is our hope that all will follow the Provincial recommendations and be fully vaccinated. We are committed to the health and safety of those who are members of our church community, our staff, our volunteers, and all those who enter our building.

It's important to note that groups using our facility must follow the regulations set out for them, and those regulations and requirements may differ from what is documented here.

Mandatory Vaccinations*

Proof of vaccination is not currently required for

- Employees of Lorne Park Baptist Church
- Volunteers
- Attendees to Sunday Services

Proof of vaccination is required for groups of 25 people or more who gather in the church building indoors for purposes *other* than Sunday worship.

Proof of Vaccinations

Following the [guidance set out by the Province](#), (pg. 7 following) proof of vaccination in the circumstances requiring it will be requested along with appropriate ID. Records will not be made publicly available and will be kept in private. For those who are unable to provide proof of vaccination, we will do our best to provide alternatives. (Example: Community Dinner - an alternative being a takeaway box if no proof is available for the attendee to eat in)

Safety Protocols

Our current COVID19 Safety Protocols will continue to be made available to everyone who enters the church building. Those safety protocols are of utmost importance and will continue to be utilized, and updated by Executive Council with the goal of keeping everyone safe and informed.
