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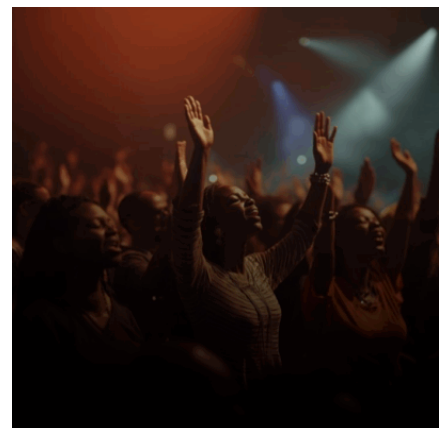

Residency (PR). Pray for continued guidance and favour as he takes the next steps in the process.

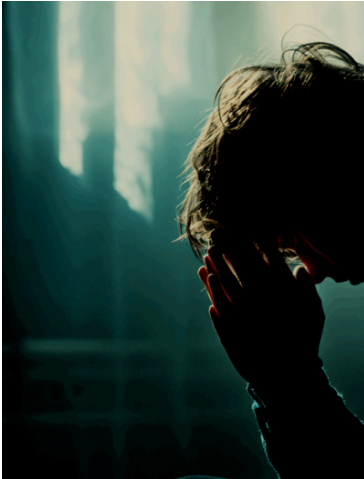

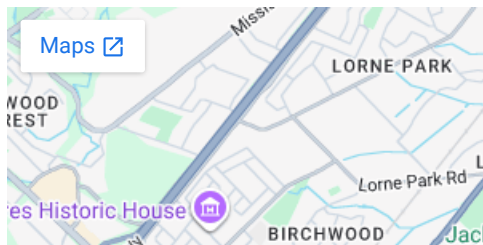
