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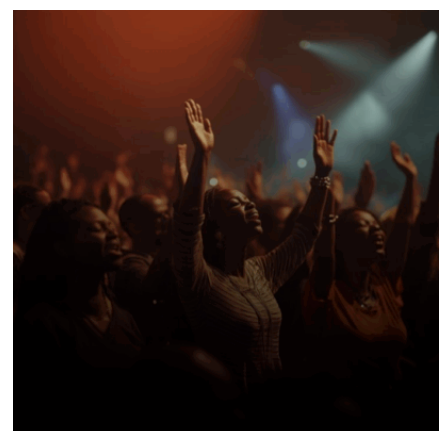
Attributes

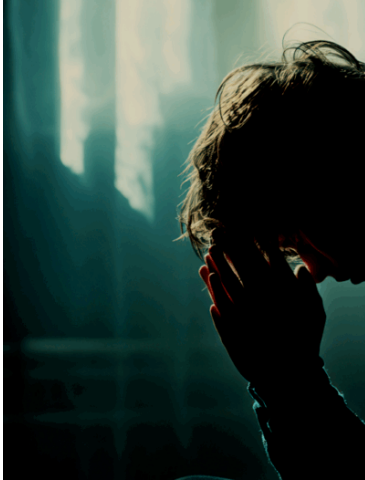

Remember those whose lives have been disrupted by violence, asking the Lord to protect the vulnerable, comfort the suffering, and bring lasting justice and peace throughout the region.
- **Pray for God's continued work among us**—within our families, our church, and our community. Ask the Holy Spirit to strengthen our faith, deepen our love for God's Word, and help us discern His leading in every circumstance. May the Lord equip us to reflect Christ's love with courage, humility, and compassion, faithfully sharing the hope of the Gospel in our daily lives.

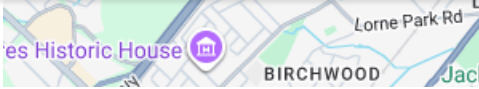
