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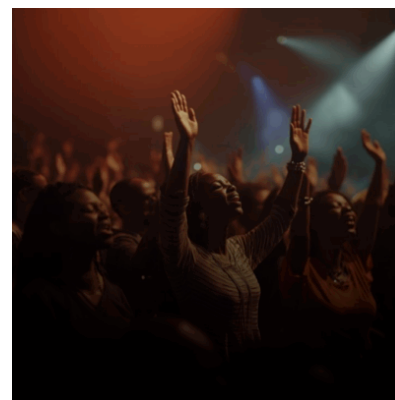

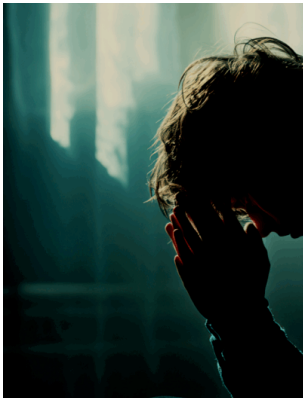


Healing

- Most of all, pray that the congregation will remain united in faith and **trust God's provision and direction**, knowing that He is present and at work even in difficult circumstances.

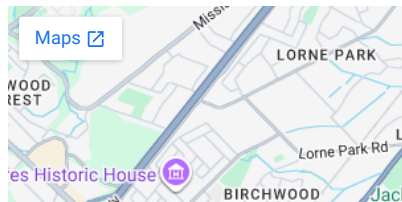
