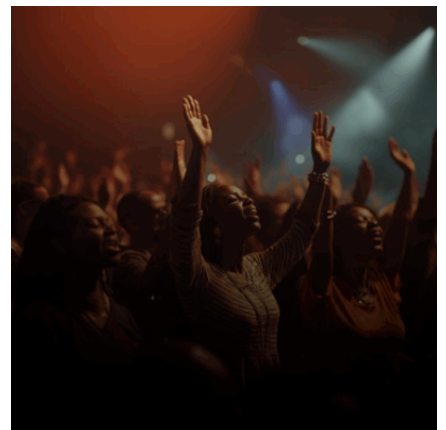
Attributes

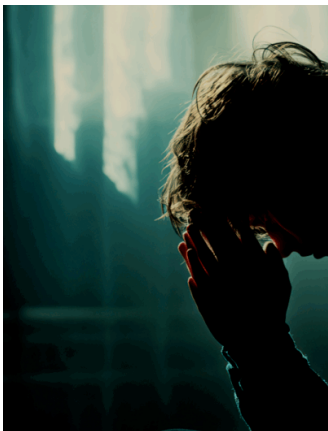


Healing

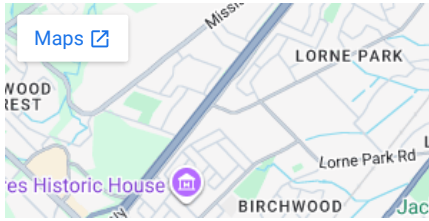
