Attributes

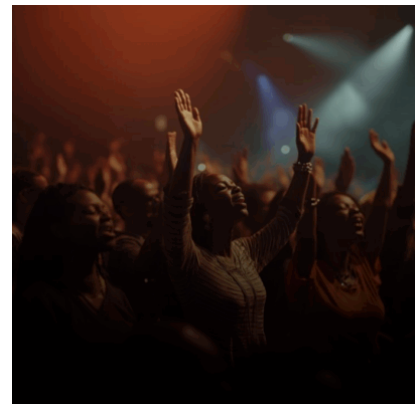
- **Gracious:** God gives unearned blessings and favor to His creation.

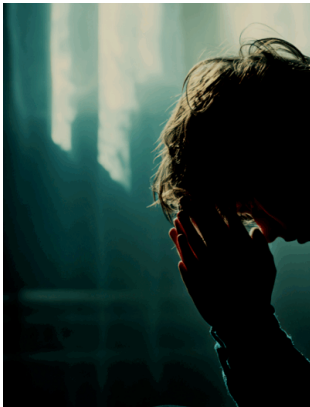


Healing

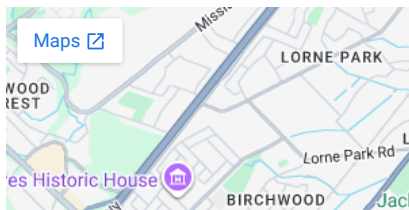
CBOQ Churches Prayer for Member Churches
