(2 Corinthians 1:3-4)

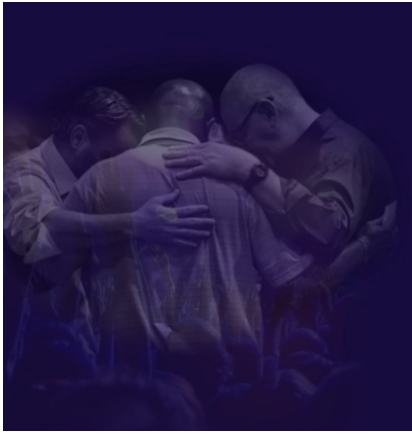

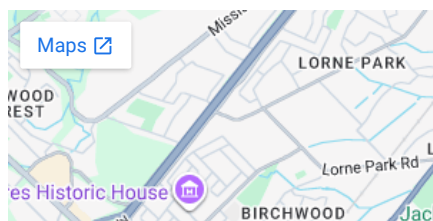
