CBOQ Churches Prayer for Member Churches

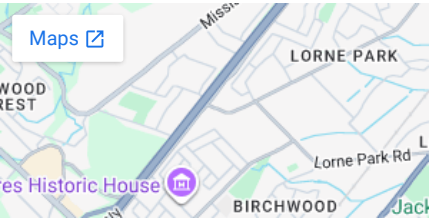
